

# Call to Action

In December the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors reviewed and accepted a Tetra Tech report evaluating the County's 2 1/2 year response to the Covid 19 incident without providing sufficient time for public comment.

- ◆ The report is lengthy, however, an experienced contract manager Lauren Cardinali addressed this at the Board of Supervisor meeting on January 24th and subsequently spoke at the San Joaquin California Republican Assembly meeting that night.
- ◆ The back of this flyer is an overview of action items to the report.
- ◆ Some of us challenged the validity of the acceptance of the report at the BOS on 2/7/21.
- ◆ The Board's initial response to those comments is that they themselves have not implemented any of the recommendations of the report, nor do they intend to even though there is an improvement plan in place.
- ◆ However, we need to verify the agencies under the board are in fact not implementing some or all of these life altering recommendations without public comment.
- ◆ We are continuing to ask questions and press for a clear understanding of the legality of this report.
- ◆ The SJCRAs has made the full report, videos and other information available on SJCRAs.org.

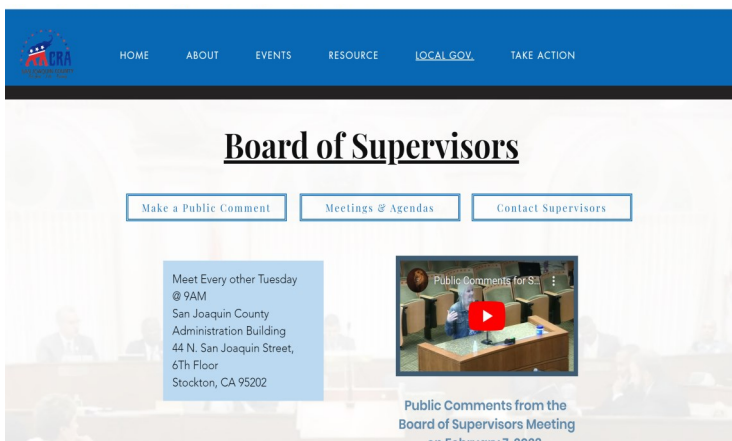

# THE COVID 19 Pandemic Response Report

## What did it Find?

Recommendations to only use FEMA - CDC - ASPR (mental health) plans for future respiratory illness incidents. Report writers did not examine or include into their review any damages, injury, harm, or cost impacts. Next steps provided for supporting unprecedented illegal aggressive steps of public agencies and expand upon giving authority to the Federal systems. Accepted on December 13th, 2022. Review Ordinance 4574 amendments.

## What will it Do?

- Activate and Deploy Federal Law Enforcement Officers (ESF-13)
- Criminalize right to body integrity, no opt out
- Forced military style countermeasures (fines or 6 months jail time)
- Board of Supervisors rendered null
- Mass Vaccine Strategy only - Shots yearly
- Train all County Staff in censorship techniques
- Use and expand costly unproven data technology that "predicts" spread
- Predatory surveillance to "specific" neighborhoods
- Continue "foresight" for future events with partners/stakeholders
- Gives Emergency Powers to selected Disaster Council

## What is Happening?

Public Health is activating the Improvement Plan with no modifications/changes. Per letter on November 4, 2022, priority action items will be orchestrated with Stake Holders. All of the costs are currently un-quantified and unqualified as to the contract value or award. No recommendations to include electorate/public.
